

## AUCTION FOR SMALL WIND AND PV INSTALLATIONS.

Pursuant to the auction timetable agreed with the Ministry of the Climate, on December 3, 2020, the last of the eight RES auctions planned for this year took place. It was dedicated to new small onshore wind and photovoltaic Installations.

The results of this auction were announced by the President of the ERO after 15 days, on 18 December 2020.

In the auction, 11 747 067,808 MWh of the 11 760 000 MWh offered and PLN 3 024 791 586,87 of the budget of PLN 4 500 000 000 were contracted. Support was granted to 747 projects of 1618 bids placed. The highest winning bid in the solar and wind basket of up to 1 MW (the so-called cut-off price) was PLN 268,88 per MWh, while the lowest bid placed was PLN 222,87 per MWH.

In comparison, in 2018 and 2019 the minimum and maximum prices at which electricity produced in renewable energy sources was "sold" at auction in the small installations basket were:

The reference prices in force in this basket (i.e. the highest prices at which bids could be submitted were:

- for wind installations (no greater than 1 MW) 320 PLN/MWh (in 2019 it was also 320 PLN/MWh);
- for PV installations (no greater than 1 MWh) 360 PLN/MWh (in 2019 it was 385 PLN/MWh).

### **RES auctions in 2021**

At the beginning of December 2020 the Ministry of Climate updated the ordinance on the maximum quantity and value of electricity produced from RES, which may be sold by auction in 2021. The ordinance should be adopted still in 2020.

The assumptions to the draft ordinance show that auctions in 2021 will contribute to the creation of almost 2,570 MW of new production capacities. The highest volume is proposed for photovoltaics - 1,800 MW.

The ministry estimates that thanks to the auctions in 2021, installations using the following volumes of energy will be created:

- onshore wind energy (> 1 MW) 600 MW,
- solar power (> 1 MW) 800 MW,
- solar power (≤ 1 MW) 1000 MW.

The above-mentioned quantities of power apply only to new installations. No sale of electricity produced in existing installations is planned.

The total estimated volume of energy intended to be sold by auction in 2021 in the 15-year period of support is 69 591 800 MWh, including 69 091 800 MWh from new installations and 500 000 MWh from existing installations.

The total maximum value of the above-mentioned volumes in the 15-year period of support is PLN 24 612 755 000, including PLN 24 277 755 000 as regards new installations and PLN 335 000 000 as regards existing installations.
